

1-Awareness and information:

The youth's participation in the various events organized periodically by the agency, either through access to the website or by bringing it closer to the branches and annexes of the agency that cover all the national territory, allows him to be informed on investment opportunities and benefits granted by the device.

2-Formulation of the project idea:

The project idea must be the result of a study and an effective research on the investment opportunities and it must be in coherence with the qualifications of the young future promotor (qualifying diploma) and its capacities for its realization.

3-Registration via the portal:

Once the choice of the project is fixed and the equipment to be acquired, the young project leader can access the website of the agency to initiate the process of electronic registration, including all data relating to his person, his partners where relevant, and its micro-enterprise.

4-The project study and business plan:

After the completion of registration phase, the project study and the elaboration of the business plan will begin in depth with the support the coach by collecting all the necessary information concerning:

- Equipment to be acquired;
- The project implementation, in particular on the environment of the future micro-enterprise;
- Market research;
- Technical choices;
- Human resources;
- Financial study.

5-Presentation of the project to the Committee of Selection, validation and Project Financing (CSVF):

At this stage of the project the young promotor must present it project at the level of the CSVF for study and decision-making by validation, adjournment or rejection.

- Validation case: submit the administrative and financial file;
- Adjournment case: the removal of the reservations made by the committee and representing the project to the committee;
- Rejection case: opportunity to submit an appeal within fifteen (15) days of notification of the committee's rejection decision.

6-Banking agreement and legal creation of micro enterprise:

- The file is submitted at the level of the bank (triangular financing) by the representative of the ANSEJ for obtaining the banking agreement.
- Upon notification of the banking agreement, the promotor proceeds to the legal creation of its microenterprise.

7-Promoter training:

- Before financing a project, the promotor must be trained in the techniques of managing of it micro-enterprise, this training is provided internally by the trainers of the ANSEJ.

8-Financing of the project:

- After the legal creation of the microenterprise and the finalization of the procedures, the ANSEJ finances the project.

9-Project implementation and start-up:

- After financing the project and finalizing the procedures for this step, you must acquire and install the equipment in order to start of the activity.
